At 29, Dave Eggers wrote his acclaimed #1 best-selling memoir *A Heartbreaking Work of Staggering Genius* and has written several subsequent best-sellers. He is also the founder of McSweeney's, a nonprofit independent publishing company, and co-founder of 826 Valencia, a network of youth writing and tutoring centers around the United States.

DOUGLAS BRINKLEY

Douglas Brinkley is the Katherine Tsanoff Brown Chair in Humanities and Professor of History at Rice University, a CNN Presidential Historian, and has received seven honorary doctorates in American Studies. Six of his books were named *New York Times* "Notable Books of the Year" and seven became *New York Times* bestsellers. He is a member of the American Academy of Arts and Letters. His most recent books *The Every* and *The Circle* examined the ways in which technology shapes and influences our lives. 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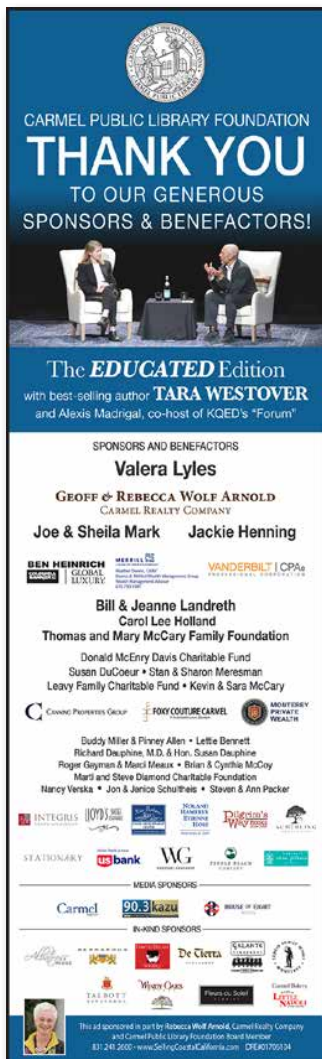
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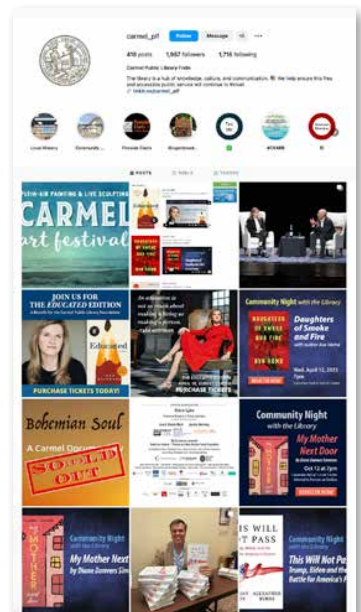
