

A Remembrance


Jim Holliday died, at 81, at his Carmel home on August 31, 2006. If some of our readers don't know the name, J.S. Holliday, then one need only to click onto Google Search to find that there are over 500,000 references to this passionate, enthusiastic, brilliant writer, speaker, administrator, and contributor to civilized, enlightened life in our village and the State of California.

Hailed as one of the greatest California historians for his seminal works, *The World Rushed In* and *Rush for Riches: Gold Fever and the Making of California*, he also authored numerous essays, criticisms, and bibliographies on the culture and texture of the past and future of the Golden State.

A tall, handsome man, he was imposing physically and intellectually. To meet him for the first time was an "experience," both startling and



daunting. His eyes seemed to demand, "tell me more; I want to know about you."

Jim Holliday was a celebrity and didn't know it and would have vehemently denied the characterization. Even with his booming voice and extravagant gestures, he was essentially a modest man. At the same time he was a "bigger-than-life" presence.

He was not only a celebrated best selling writer and historian, but was a director of the renowned Bancroft Library on the UC campus, Berkeley, as well as Director of the Oakland Museum. Jim was the Executive Director of the California Historical Society for many years.

It is a near impossibility to chronicle the extent of J.S. Holliday's accomplishments. He was a man of great stature; a thoughtful, compassionate advocate of the underclass; an eminent intellectual; a family man, devoted husband and father.

It took Jim three decades to write *The World Rushed In*. Every word was spelled out on a standard Royal typewriter. It was worth the wait, for as soon as the book was published, the critics and the public hailed it as a spectacular achievement. In November of last year, the State of California honored Jim. The Rare Book Room at the California State Library, Sacramento, had a name change. It is now called The J.S. Holliday Rare Book Room. Belinda Vidor Holliday, his widow, unveiled a bust of her husband at the ceremony.

The accolades were legion but none as apt as one critic noted: J.S. Holliday—"the most extraordinary of all California historians." Jim is remembered with admiration and great affection.


